Q1: ANAND-ICE is approved to which statutory body?

A1: ANAND-ICE is approved by *All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi*.

Q2: To which university is ANAND-ICE affiliated?

A2: ANAND-ICE is affiliated to **Rajasthan Technical University (RTU), Kota** established by the Government of Rajasthan. The examination is conducted through RTU and the degree “B. Tech. - Bachelor of Technology” is awarded through RTU.

Q3: What is the grading of ANAND-ICE amongst all the affiliated colleges under RTU, Kota ?

A3: ANAND-ICE has been awarded Grade “A” in Rajasthan amongst all RTU affiliated colleges in session 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24.

Q4: Is there any program through which training can be done abroad?

Q6: How many days are working for students at ANAND-ICE?

A6: At Anand-ICE 5 days a week are working for first year, second year and third year students and 3 days a week working for fourth year students.

A7: There is no uniform rule at Anand-ICE. A dress code is followed comprising formal dress code for 3 days a week and casual dress code for 2 days.

Q10: What are the infrastructure and other facilities at ANAND-ICE?

A10: The campus is set up amidst lush green environs away from the humdrum of city life, at the same time is well connected to the city by the Jaipur – Agra National Highway. It is a place where ideas are born, leaders are created, and lives are transformed. Some of the highlights are:

Q11: Is there any ragging of new students at Anand-ICE?

A11: Absolutely not; Anand-ICE has "Zero Tolerance Policy" on ragging. We have constituted Anti-Ragging Committee as well as Anti-Ragging Squads for College & Hostel. Anyone found guilty of ragging or abetting ragging is liable to be punished which may include rustication and lodging of police complaint.

Q12: What facilities like internet, gym etc. are provided to the hostellers of Anand-ICE and are they included in the hostel fee?

A12: The Anand-ICE hostel facilities include Attached Toilets with Rooms, Mess, Separate Recreational Halls with TV, Gymnasium with an Instructor, RO Drinking Water, 24*7 Electricity, Wi-Fi, Hot Water Supply, 24*7 Study & Computer Center, Medical assistance, Guest House, Indoor & Outdoor Sports Facility including Squash Court, Basketball, Volleyball, Football, Badminton, Kabaddi, Cricket Net Practice Pitch and much more under the supervision of a coach. All the mentioned facilities are included in the hostel fee.

Q13: Is there any laundry service in the hostel at Anand-ICE and is it included in the hostel fee?

A13: Yes, Anand-ICE facilitates laundry service for the residents on a chargeable basis.

Q14: Is there any medical facility provided in the hostel at Anand-ICE?

A14: Anand-ICE provides medical assistance to the hostel residents. Medical kit is available in each hostel for minor injuries/illness. We have tie-ups with a few nearby hospitals which can be reached by college ambulance in case of an emergency.

Q15: Does Anand-ICE have a department store in the campus and till what time is it open?

A15: Yes, Anand-ICE has a department store in the campus.

Q16: How is the mess food and how is the food menu decided at Anand-ICE?

A16: The mess at Anand-ICE offers four meals a day hygienic food to the hostellers. All the quality standards are duly taken care and the food quality is double checked by a committee of wardens. The menu is decided by the Mess Committee which includes students as well as hostel resident staff as members from the Master Menu. It is reviewed monthly.

Q17: What is the night in time for hostel students and till what time is a student allowed to roam inside the campus at Anand-ICE?

A17: Students must be in the campus premises before 7:30 pm. Students can roam inside the campus till 10 pm (for boys) and 9.00 pm (for girls). However, only the 24*7 study center facility is open 24*7 for both boys and girls.

Q18: How is the security of the students residing in the hostel at Anand-ICE?

A18: At Anand-ICE, we take utmost care of the security of the hostel residents. The wardens extend round the clock supervision in the hostel. Security staff is present on campus 24*7. Additionally, the entire campus is under CCTV surveillance.

Q19: Does Anand-ICE provide transportation facility for the hostellers to the city during the weekends?

A19: Yes, Anand-ICE provides transport facility for the hostellers on every alternate Sundays to the city.

Q20: Till what time is the library open for hostel students at Anand-ICE?

A20: The Anand-ICE campus has 2 libraries. The college library is open till 04.00 pm as well as the 24*7 study and computer center is open 24*7 for hostellers.

Q21: What are the initiatives undertaken by ANAND-ICE to help the students become more industry ready?

A21:

- a) Enabling the students to be corporate ready, Anand-ICE ensures maximum industry integration throughout their educational journey. The team works in close connection with the industry and has established 200+ industrial tie-ups across the country to provide corporate exposure to the students in the form of student internship, regular industrial visits, hosting corporate talk shows and conducting webinars.
- b) In order to meet the highly diverse demands of the workplace, Anand-ICE has its own 180 hours Personality Grooming Program for its students with a dedicated team of best trainers inculcating in them all the required soft skills needed by the industry apart from the technical skills.
- c) For bridging the gap between industry needs and RTU academic syllabus, Anand-ICE has brought up with Anand-Edge which is instrumented with many industry-led courses and specialized courses in engineering disciplines and sub-disciplines meeting expectations of employers and industries. This includes Active Spoken Tutorial center of IIT Mumbai, active NPTEL Center with seven Core IITs and IISc Bangalore, Nodal Center in the state of Rajasthan for Virtual Labs with IIT Mumbai, to name a few.

Q22: What kind of jobs routinely come to ANAND-ICE campus? What are the key recruitment trends for ANAND-ICE observed over the past few years?

A22: ANAND-ICE has a strong Placement Team which works 365 days in a year to establish close connections with the industries throughout the country for student placements. The Team also rigorously trains the students to prepare for campus drives which include conduction of Mock Group Discussions, Personal Interviews and Company Orientation.

ANAND-ICE offers good core as well as non-core job opportunities to its students with average annual package being 5 LPA and highest package being 18 LPA in 2023. Some students also bag more than one job offer which gives them the option to choose the most suitable for them. The recruitment graph of ANAND-ICE has been constantly rising in terms of quality of job opportunities and salaries bagged by the students. Despite the downfall in the market situations, ANAND-ICE has been a preferred choice of the corporate.


FAQs for Admission to B.Tech. Program

Q1: What is the eligibility criterion for admission in B.Tech. program?

A1: A candidate must have passed class 10+2 (12th) examinations with Physics and/or Mathematics / Chemistry/ Computer Science/ Electronics/ Information Technology/ Biology/ Informatics Practices/ Biotechnology/ Technical Vocational subject/ Agriculture/ Engineering Graphics/ Business Studies/ Entrepreneurship.(Any of the three) Obtained at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category SC/ ST/ Non creamy layer OBC/ Non creamy layer MBC and PwD category of Rajasthan State) in the above subjects taken together in the final examination of Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan(RBSE) or Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) or any other examination recognized and equivalent thereto by Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan/Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).

OR

Passed min. 3 years Diploma examination with at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category SC/ ST/ Non creamy layer OBC/ Non creamy layer MBC and PwD category of Rajasthan State) subjected to vacancies in the First Year, in case the vacancies at lateral entry are exhausted. Note: (1) List of Technical Vocational Subject is in accordance to the RBSE and CBSE Board. (2) The Universities will offer suitable bridge courses such as Mathematics, Physics, Engineering drawing, etc., for the students coming from diverse backgrounds to achieve desired learning outcomes of the programme. Subject combination required in the qualifying examination for admission to B.E. / B.Tech. course shall be as under: Candidates must obtained at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in any of the below three subjects taken together.

Q2: Is there any age criteria in REAP-2024 admission Process?

A2: No, there is no age limit.

Q3: Is the candidate with class-12 from NIOS Board eligible for admission in B.Tech. programme?

A3: Yes, the candidate with class-12 from NIOS Board is eligible for admission in B.Tech. programme subject to fulfillment of eligibility criterion.

Q4: Is the candidate who has compartment in any subject in class-12/Diploma eligible?

A4: No, the candidate must have passed all subjects (without compartment) in class-12/ Diploma before the last date of filling of REAP-2024 application form/ Management quota.

Q5: What is the seat matrix under Self Financing Scheme (SFS) category for admission in B.Tech. programme at ANAND-ICE?

A5: The division of approved intake for B.Tech. programme is as follows:

The admission process is as follows:

5.1 For Out of Rajasthan state and Rajasthan state candidates: Eligible candidates can apply through REAP website (<https://cegreap2024.com/>) by filling an online Application cum Registration Form as per REAP schedule.

5.2 For Management Quota: Candidates need to apply in person at Institute premises for admission under this category.

Q6: Is there a provision of supernumerary (additional) seats under various schemes other than approved intake for admission in B.Tech. programme?

A6: Yes, the supernumerary (additional) seats under TFWS (5%) and Kashmiri Migrants (5%) in each branch as per AICTE.

Q7: What is the REAP code of ANAND-ICE?

A7: The REAP code of ANAND-ICE (Anand International College of Engineering), Jaipur is **1124**.

Q8: Is the candidate holding Diploma (3 years) eligible to apply for admission in B.Tech. programme through REAP-2024?

A8: Yes, the candidate who holds the Diploma (3 years) in Engineering & Technology is eligible to apply for admission in any branch of 1st year B.Tech. programme through REAP-2024.

Q9: **What is the criterion for applying as domicile of Rajasthan state in REAP-2024?**
 A9: The Domicile Certificate of Rajasthan State is issued by the competent authority/ Govt. of Rajasthan. In absence of above prescribed formats (available on REAP-2024 website).

Q10: **How many rounds will be conducted for admission in B.Tech. programme through REAP-2024?**

A10: There would be six main rounds of the centralized counseling in admission process of REAP-2024 except management quota admission.

In the **First Round**, TFWS Seats Allotment and Reporting.

In the **Second Round** TFWS upward Movement-I Seats Allotment and Reporting.

In the **Third Round** TFWS upward Movement-II Seats Allotment and Reporting.

In the **Fourth Round** Out of Rajasthan, Ex. Serviceman, PWD, KM candidates Seats Allotment and Reporting.

In the **Fifth Round** Rajasthan State Candidates Seats Allotment and Reporting.

In the **Sixth Round** Direct Admission on vacant seats and Management Quota Admission at institute level .

Q11: **Is there a provision of management quota for admission in B.Tech. programme at ANAND-ICE?**

A11: Yes, 15% seats of approved intake in each branch are reserved for all candidates. They have to apply in person for admission in B.Tech. programme under management quota at ANAND-ICE Campus, Jaipur only.

Q13: How to apply for online REAP-2024 Application cum Registration Form for admission in B.Tech. programme (other than Management Quota)?

A13: All candidates must follow the following steps for admission in B.Tech. program while filling the online REAP-2024 Application cum Registration Form on REAP-2024 website <https://cegreap2024.com/>

13.1 Step-1: Deposition of Application cum Registration Form fee

13.1.1. Fee for REAP-2024 Application cum Registration Form is Rs. 295/- (non-refundable/non-transferable) excluding transactional charges (if any).

13.1.2. The REAP-2024 Application cum Registration Form will automatically become active after successful payment.

13.2 Step-2: Necessary documents to be kept ready before filling the REAP-2024 Application Form

13.2.1. Mobile number and email ID of the candidate.

13.2.2. Scanned image of candidate's Photograph in jpg format (Maximum size 100 KB)

13.2.3. Scanned image of candidate's Signature in jpg format (Maximum size 50 KB)

13.2.3. Scanned images of mark sheets of Class-10th & 12th or equivalent (Maximum size 150 KB)

13.2.4. JEE Score Card (if applicable).

13.2.5. Caste Certificate (if applicable).

13.2.6. Domicile Certificate (if applicable).

13.2.7. EWS Certificate (if applicable).

13.2.8. Income Certificate (If applicable).

Note: All scanned images must be clear & legible.

13.3 Step-3: Instructions for filling online REAP-2024 Application cum Registration Form

13.3.1. The candidate must read instructions before filling the online REAP-2024 Application cum Registration Form carefully.

13.3.2. All the entries in online REAP-2024 Application cum Registration Form must be filled as required.

13.3.3. The candidate must upload all the requisite documents as instructed on the web portal.

- 13.3.4. The candidate has to fill option/ choice form carefully after successful completion of REAP- 2021 Application cum Registration Form.
- 13.3.5. The online REAP-2024 Application cum Registration Form can be edited (if required) before final submission.
- 13.3.6. No changes can be made in the option/ choice form and REAP-2024 Application cum Registration Form after final submission in any circumstances.

13.4 Step-4: Taking Printouts/Hardcopy only after final submission of application form. The candidate may take printouts of REAP-2024 Application cum Registration Form and option/choice form, which will be generated after final submission.

Q14: Is physical presence of the candidate mandatory at the time of reporting at allotted college?

A14: Yes, the physical presence of the candidate is mandatory at time of reporting at the allotted college.

Q15: What are the documents required for admission in B.Tech. programme at the time of reporting?

A15: Candidates must carry original documents along with their self-attested photocopies for verification of the eligibility of admission at the time of reporting. The list of supporting documents is mentioned below:

Q16: Is medical fitness certificate mandatory for admission in B.Tech. programme?

A16: Yes, the prescribed medical fitness certificate duly signed by a doctor (which is available on REAP website) is mandatory at the time of admission.

Q17: What is the college fee for B.Tech. programme?

A17: The fee for SFS, EWS & KM categories approved by the State Level Fee Determination Committee (appointed by Govt. of Rajasthan) and/or Competent Authority is as follows
