All students are hereby informed that the college has prescribed guidelines regarding dress, grooming and professional appearance to promote discipline, safety, professionalism, institutional identity and workplace readiness.



WEEKLY DRESS CODE

Tuesday to Friday → FORMAL DRESS

Monday & Saturday → SMART CASUAL DRESS

DOs

- ✓ Wear clean, neat and properly ironed clothes.
- ✓ Display your College Identity Card at all times.
- ✓ Maintain proper personal hygiene and grooming.
- ✓ prescribed formal/traditional attire and appropriate footwear for girls.
- ✓ Maintain neat and well-groomed hair and a clean, well-maintained beard, if any.
- ✓ Wear minimal and appropriate accessories.
- ✓ Wear closed-toe shoes and prescribed PPE in laboratories/workshops.
- ✓ Keep long hair securely tied back in laboratories/workshops.
- ✓ Follow additional dress requirements communicated for specific events.

DON'Ts

- ✗ No T-shirts during formal-dress days, including round-neck/V-neck T-shirts.
- ✗ No jeans, cargo pants or low-waist trousers on formal-dress days.
- ✗ No shorts, slippers/flip-flops on smart-casual days.
- ✗ No ripped or distressed clothing.
- ✗ No crop tops, excessively tight-fitting or otherwise inappropriate attire.
- ✗ No transparent or inappropriate clothing.
- ✗ No clothing displaying obscene, abusive, offensive or discriminatory messages/prints.
- ✗ No excessively long, coloured or unconventional hairstyles.
- ✗ Avoid flashy or distracting jewellery/accessories.
- ✗ Do not wear loose clothing or dangling accessories in laboratories/workshops.
